Crime and Safety update

Around 25 locals attended our community safety meeting in May at the CFA to discuss the crime issues and consider if there was any interest in forming a Neighbourhood Watch for Red Hill.

Despite the turnout, there was little interest in forming a Neighbourhood Watch, so the idea has been abandoned for the time being. Instead, we will keep you up-to-date via this newsletter and our website.

Senior Constable Julie Simpson gave a highly informative talk on crime prevention and she made the following recommendations:

- call 000 if you see suspicious behaviour, this helps with data and Police resourcing
- lock your car and keep valuables out of sight
- make your home looked 'lived in' at all times by having lights on and bins taken out and brought in regularly
- let your neighbours know when you are not going to be around and ask them to keep an eye out for you.

Our committee member Tom Orr said his neighbours reported someone trying to enter their home by pretending to be a council officer. When confronted she could not produce any identification, and although continuing to argue that she should be allowed access, she was eventually turned away.
